



FORESTVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOL- NON-LOCAL ENROLMENT APPLICATION

In accordance with department of education guidelines, parents/carers may apply for enrolment at a school to which they are not local. In order to do this, a separate application is required to be completed. This can be accessed online via <https://forestvill-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/about-our-school/enrolment.html>

To be eligible for placement in a non-local school, one or more of the following criteria must be addressed as part of the application process.

Criteria (Not in any order of priority)

- Siblings already enrolled at the school
- Proximity and access to the school
- Medical reasons
- Safety & supervision of the student before and after school
- Availability of subjects or combinations of subjects
- Structure and organisation of the school
- Recent change in the local intake area boundaries

Criteria for consideration does not include a student's academic ability, performance or achievement.

When completing the "Non-local Area Application Form", clear and concise reference to the above criteria should be included and should specifically support a case for enrolment of a student. Additional information may be included in the application where appropriate.

Applications for non-local enrolment are overseen by a panel which includes, the Principal or delegate, a staff representative and a parent representative. This panel meets as required, usually within a fortnight of applications being submitted.

Applications may be rejected based on a number of factors including

- Lack of available space within the school
- False or misleading information within a submission
