#### **ELECTRONIC SIGN**

#### PAINTING

We have tried to limit the impact on teachers and students but there will be some classes who will need to change rooms. These works will also go throughout January, so I expect the impact on the school's appearance will be significant starting next year. It is wonderful that the department is prioritising these works to ensure improvement and maintenance of our facilities.

## **BUS & ROAD SAFETY**



Children are most at risk in the minutes after getting off the bus.

To improve safety:

- Wait until the bus has gone, then use a safe place to cross e.g. school crossing
- Model safe pedestrian behavior. Stop! Look! Listen! Think! every time you cross the road and keep checking until safely across.
- Up until at least 10 years old, supervise closely and hold your child's hand when crossing the road.
