GROWTH MINDSET- INTEGRITY – The moral compass

During your child's growing up years, success is often defined by academic scores and extracurricular accomplishments.

Children are not born with integrity or the behaviours we associate with it, including humility, social responsibility, and the courage to stand up for what they believe is right. It is derived through a process of cultural socialization—influences from all spheres of a child's life.

This process begins at home and is supported by schools. While kids are influenced by many outof-home factors in today's world, research shows that families are still the primary teachers of integrity and the behaviours associated with it.

Ways to grow your child's integrity:

- 1. Have and articulate strong family values develop a moral vocabulary.
- 2. Reward respectful behaviour
- 3. Explore consequences
- 4. Be a role model: respond with integrity.

- Teach digital etiquette and citizenship.
- 6. Share meaningful stories much is learned through narrative.
- 7. Instill self –efficacy: teach them to believe in themselves.

Primary Ethics information



Do something life-changing today

For around an hour a week, you can teach an ethics class at Forestville Public School and help children, our future leaders, develop skills for life.

Ethics classes support children to develop the skills they need to voice their opinions, consider the ideas of others and to make decisions based on evidence and reasoning rather than habit or peer pressure.

In ethics classes volunteers help children discuss ethical issues using an approved curriculum designed for each age group and include topics such as: Laziness; Voting; How can we work out what's true?; and, Imagining how others feel.

Classes are 30 minutes in length and start at 9AM on Thursdays (for years 3 to 6) and Fridays (for kindergarten and years 1 and 2). Comprehensive training, access to lesson materials and classroom support are all provided. Previous teaching experience is not required.

Griffith University is conducting an Australian wide study on anxiety treatment for 7 – 12 year olds that offers free home-based assessment and treatment for 7 to 12 year old children with fear and anxiety disorders.

About the study

The team at Griffith University may be able to assist you. We are conducting a nationwide study that includes the following services at no cost to families:

- A thorough assessment of your child's anxiety with a trained psychologist via the telephone;
- Your child receiving one of two kinds of home-based treatments delivered on a PC, laptop or tablet; and
- Two follow-up telephone assessments with a trained psychologist 6- and 12months after treatment to track your child's progress.

The study aims to find out if these two treatments are as effective as each other, and which children have the best response to each kind of treatment. This will mean that there are more evidence-based treatments available for helping anxious children.
